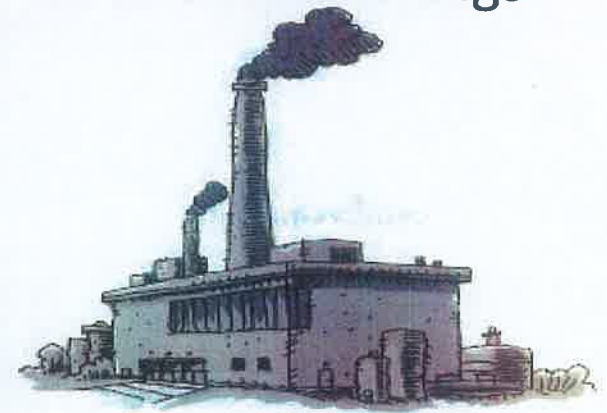


One of the things we can do to use less oil is to not use our cars to much. You shouldn't use your car if you are only going a kilometer or a mile.
